For those of you going to the North Florida Fair, this is only 56 miles from the fairgrounds and you will be able to go directly from the rally to the fair if you wish.

We will be able to check in at the rally on 10/31.

There will be no other fees for registration or for food at this rally. Your only cost will be camping fees. Mail that to Barbara Rotunda and she will pay the campground.

Rally Details

- The campground is located on US19 just south of the Big Bend Technical College and the Forest Capital Hall. They have over 100 paved sites. Most of them are pull thru. 30 & 50 amp hook-ups. Water, sewer and electric.
- Our camping fee will be \$52 per night.

Also available:

- One 2 bedroom park model, fully furnished \$125 per night. Reserve early with Barbara Rotunda.
- * Two Deluxe cabins with bathroom, kitchenette and linens. \$106 per night. Reserve early with Barbara Rotunda.
- Several Standard cabins. Double bed and a set of bunk beds, a refrigerator, heat and a/c, Tv. No linens are supplied with these. They are very close (about 175 ft) from bathhouse. \$50 per night.
- ADA bathhouse with a separate entry code
- For anyone who is interested, there is a Holiday Day Inn Express about 6-8 blocks down the street. Also a Hampton Inn.
- The registration form is at the end of this newsletter.
 We would like to have all registrations in by
 September 15 in order to complete preparations for meals and other plans.
